Please can anyone with any time come and help us get on top of our allotment again! We have had the grass strimmed but more is needed to get it back under control. If anyone has any time, please let me know.

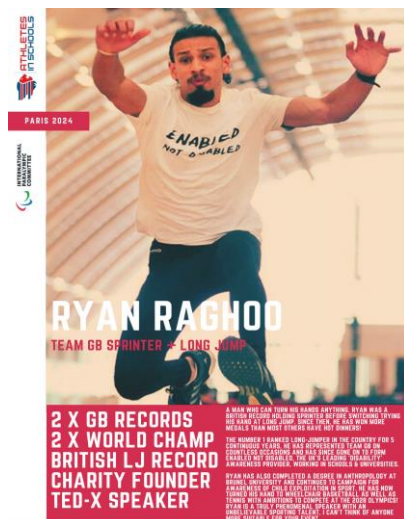
Forest School – Maple and Beech Class

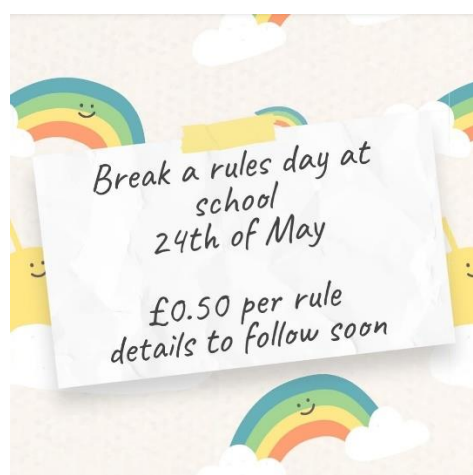
PFA News
